<b>Possible Side Effects</b>	Runny nose, cough, nasal congestion, headache, muscle aches, fever, wheezing, abdominal pain or occasional vomiting or diarrhea	Soreness, redness, tenderness, or swelling where the shot was given. Fainting, headache, muscle aches, fever, and nausea.
<b>Who shouldn't receive the vaccine</b>	Adults 50+ Children 6 months-2 years of age. Children younger than 5 with asthma or one or more episodes of wheezing within the past year People with long –term health problems. Anyone with any muscle or nerve disorders that can lead to breathing or swallowing problems. Anyone weakened immune system. Children or adolescents on a long-term aspirin treatment.	Anyone with severe (life threatening) allergy to eggs, or any other substance in the vaccine.  Anyone who is moderately or severely ill, wait until you recover before getting the vaccine.  Tell the person giving you the vaccine if you have any severe allergies.
